### **General Information**



Artizan Gallery is an independent fine art gallery dedicated to championing the work of local artists in the South West.

Our inviting gallery space offers a professional, affordable venue for both experienced and emerging artists, as well as providing a venue for events, groups and workshops.



Artizan Gallery is located on Lucius Street in Torquay.

It is free to enter.

The opening times are:
11am-6pm Tuesday to Friday
10am-6pm Saturday

You can visit the gallery before these opening hours by booking an appointment. This has been particularly useful for those who have been shielding.

# **Getting there**



Artizan Gallery is easily accessed by car. There is parking available on both Lucius Street and Tor Church Road which is the road behind the gallery.

Parking is limited to 1 hour.



There are two bus stops nearby. The number 22, 35A and 35C stop on Lucius Street.

The Land Train also stops on Lucius Street.

### **Facilities**



There is one toilet in the gallery.

It is located between the Main Gallery and the Courtyard Gallery.

The nearest accessible toilets can be found on Market Street and on Torquay Seafront. These are both public toilets that you have to pay to use.

# Inside the Gallery



There are three steps up to enter the gallery from the front entrance.

There is an accessible entrance at the back of the gallery where you can enter via the courtyard. This will bring you into the Courtyard Gallery and café which is accessible for wheelchair users.

If you need to use this entrance please let a member of staff know or alternatively contact us before your visit.

There are 2 steps up into this room.




There is a café in the Courtyard Gallery. We offer a table service with hot drinks available.




As you head back towards the main entrance you will see the stairs down to the Basement Gallery.
